Birds move in response to Climate Change

ABC 7.- Recent findings confirm that birds move in response to changes in climate. Of 53 species, 48 in the Sierra Nevada Mountains have adjusted to climate change over the last century by moving to sites with temperatures and precipitations conditions they favored.

The study, conducted in collaboration with Audubon California, includes data from 82 sites in the Sierra Nevada and **details the changes in birds' geographic range** over the course of a century.

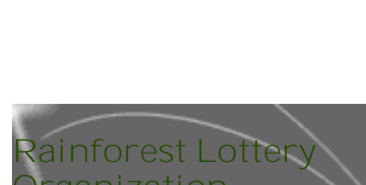
